Bringing Birmingham's Story to Life

Vulcan Park and Museum offers the only comprehensive museum of Birmingham's history. Storytelling, hands-on exhibits and activities, and live music and theater make our programs engaging for students. Our educational programs include lessons in social studies, language arts, math, science, and fine arts. Guided tours are available for the youngest of learners all the way up to high school aged students.
