Now Accepting Nominations for The Vulcans Community Awards 2015

Birmingham, Ala. — Vulcan Park and Museum is once again calling for nominations for *The Vulcans Community Awards*. *The Vulcans awards* honor citizens who exemplify civic pride, leadership and progress within the seven-county metro area. Nominations are open until July 31 in five award categories: *Lifetime Achievement, Servant Leadership, Hero, Game Changer* and *Newcomer*.
